Public Disclosure of Student Achievement

Reinhardt University tracks each academic year the rates at which students complete courses, remain at the institution, graduate, and pass licensing exams. The institution also assesses its general education student learning outcomes by tracking graduating seniors' scores on the ETS Proficiency Profile.

Measure 1: Course Completion Rate

Successful course completion at the undergraduate level means earning a grade of A, B, C, D, or P. Reinhardt's goal for successful course completion is to maintain an overall rate of at least 85%.

Measure 2: First-Year Retention Rate

Retention rates are calculated for each cohort of first-time, full-time undergraduate students enrolled at Reinhardt in the fall semester. The first-year retention rate is the percentage of the freshman cohort who return to Reinhardt the following fall. Reinhardt's goal for this measure is to maintain a rate of at least 62%, representing the average for peer institutions of similar size and student demographics.

Measure 3: Graduation Rate

Graduation rates are calculated for each cohort of first-time, full-time freshmen. The 6-year graduation rate for Bachelor's degree seeking students is expressed as the percentage of first-time, full-time freshmen who graduate within six years (150% of "Normal Time" to completion for Bachelor's programs). Graduation rates do not include students who transfer to and graduate from other institutions after receiving a strong foundation from Reinhardt. The University's goal for this measure is to reach and maintain a rate of at least 38%, representing the average for its peer group.

In addition, Reinhardt tracks graduation within 150% of “Normal Time” for full-time transfer students: within 5 years for freshman-level transfers, within 4 years for sophomore-level transfers, and within 3 years for junior-level transfers. The University’s goal for the graduation of transfer students is to maintain a rate of at least 50%.

Measure 4: Licensing Passage Rate

The Price School of Education (PSOE) students are required by the Georgia Professional Standards Commission to take an external examination for licensure in their field in order to teach in the state’s public school system. Below are the PSOE students’ pass rates for the Georgia Assessments for the Certification of Educators (GACE) over the past three years. PSOE’s goal for the GACE pass rate is to exceed the statewide pass rates. For the past three years, the PSOE’s pass rate exceeded the statewide pass rate.

Measure 5: ETS Proficiency Profile Score

Each year, graduating seniors take the ETS Proficiency Profile, a standardized test that assesses general education proficiencies and student attainment of the university’s general education student learning outcomes. Reinhardt’s goal for this measure is to score at or above the national mean when compared to all students at Liberal Arts Baccalaureate Colleges. For the past three years, Reinhardt’s average total score ranked at or above the national for the comparison group.
