
Auto-Open Inline Preview Instructions with New RCE

- 1. Go to the Course Home Page.
- 2. Click the edit button.
- 3. Click on the down arrow located next to the icon of a document to choose the "Upload Documents" option.



4. Then, click on "Upload Document." From this drop-down window, you can also choose documents that have been saved to your course or in Canvas. However, to pull a document from your computer, click "Upload Document." You can also follow the same process by clicking on "Insert" -> "Document".




5. Click on the Rocket ship to access your computer's hard drive.



8. Highlight the file and then click on the highlighted file. You will see a box appear that says Link Options.



9. Click on Link Options. A pull-out window to your right will appear.



By choosing "Preview Inline" and "Expand Preview by Default", your document will automatically open in the RCE. By choosing Preview in overlay, the document will not open automatically in the RCE. Rather, it will give students the option click the link to open the file in an new overlay window.

10. Don't forget to save your changes.
