

UNIVERSITY-LEVEL PREVENTION AND RESPONSE TO COVID-19

Reinhardt University is committed to promoting the health and safety of its students, faculty and staff. In an effort to understand how COVID-19 is impacting our community and determine appropriate actions, Reinhardt has developed prevention and response measures resulting in a color-coded alert system.

Reinhardt University's prevention and response measures are determined by three key factors:

- Local, state and national executive orders and declarations
- Regional environmental conditions
- Campus environmental conditions

The color-coded alert system is informed by Reinhardt's tracking of COVID-19 cases, hospitalizations, and deaths locally and regionally. The information gathered from these sources and use of benchmarks allow Reinhardt to indicate severity. Using these measures, Reinhardt defines conditions and actions within the color-coded alert system.

Each color within the Color-Coded Alert System directs Reinhardt's actions in support of the health and safety of students, faculty, staff and all who visit campus.

Reinhardt University will communicate the current condition of the campus, and the circumstance or circumstances triggering that designation.

COLOR-CODED ALERT SYSTEM

Condition Red

Action: Reinhardt University will operate under condition "Red" when any of the following circumstances are met:

1. Federal, State, or Local jurisdictions have issued an active, general "Shelter-in-Place" order.
2. The number of students on the Main Campus requiring isolation reaches Reinhardt's ability to provide isolation. Reinhardt is able to provide isolation for 20 students.

COLOR-CODED ALERT SYSTEM CONT:

Condition Yellow

Action: Reinhardt University will operate under condition “Yellow” when any of the following circumstances are met:

1. Federal, State, or Local jurisdictions have issued an active public health state of emergency.
2. The number of students on the Main Campus requiring isolation reaches two-thirds of our capacity to provide isolation. Two-thirds of our capacity to provide isolation is 14 students.
3. Environmental conditions indicate increasing severity of COVID-19 that may impact our ability to provide for students requiring isolation. Reinhardt is tracking new cases, hospitalizations, and deaths based on data provided by the Georgia Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency (GEMA) and has established benchmarks that will trigger condition "Yellow."

Condition Green

Action: Reinhardt University will operate under condition “Green” absent conditions triggering conditions “Yellow” or “Red.”
