Reinhardt University Alumni of the Year Award

Eligibility, Criteria, Nomination, and Selection Process

The Alumni of the Year Award recognizes a Reinhardt graduate whose life exemplifies the University's vision, values, and ethos and whose work has made significant impact and achieved at the highest levels.

Eligibility and Criteria

- The nominee must be a Reinhardt University alum.
- The individual must have achieved outstanding accomplishments in their profession, business, or community at the highest levels.
- The individual must demonstrate significant leadership, service, and achievement whether through their profession, community engagement, or other meaningful contributions.
- The nominee must embody Reinhardt's vision, values, and educational ethos. Nominees currently serving on the Alumni Board of Governors are not eligible.
- The recipient should display meaningful service and contributions to Reinhardt University and the alumni community.
- Nominations may be made posthumously to honor deceased alumni.

Selection and Presentation

- All members of the Reinhardt alumni community are eligible to submit nominations.
- All nomination materials must be received by November 1 to be considered.
- The Recognition Committee of the Alumni Board of Governors will review the pool of submissions and recommend finalists.
- Finalists will be presented to the Vice President for Advancement and the President of the University for selection.
- One recipient may be honored each year.

Process for Nominating an Alumni of the Year Award Recipient

Nominations must be submitted through the online nomination form. The form should include a brief biography of the nominee that covers:
